We follow on ahead serving our Lord Jesus Christ faithfully because it is the best we can do for our Marvelous and worthy Saviour. He deserves all our lives as a sacrifice to his grace.

We ask your prayers for a van to carry people to church. Many here have no transportation and they live a distance from the church house. In the evenings it can be dangerous on foot in this city. We would then ask you to help us purchase a twelve passenger van. We have a smaller bus and sometimes we use our small car. We have to make two trips each way to bring them to church. The cost will be about \$14,409.00. We ask you also to help us pray for a central air conditioner unit that will cost about \$2045.00.

We continue here representing you all with a clean mind, a heart clean and a clear conscience before our God.

Many thanks to you all. We are praying for all the pastors, churches, and brethren that help us. We try to pray for you all each and every day. God bless you all richly.
